- *This program is designed specifically for students who have already completed an A.S. or A.A.S. Degree. Students who have completed an A.A. Degree may also apply.*
- *Students must complete a total of 36 hours of General Education courses to graduate, including both Associate Degree level and Bachelor's Degree level courses.*
- *Students may need to meet additional program requirements for graduation based on previous credits earned. Please contact an IRSC Advisor for more information.*
- *Students who have not taken two years of the same foreign language in high school will need to complete two semesters or 8 credit hours of the same foreign language at the college level to meet the state foreign language requirement.*

NOTE: *Students must have completed the foreign language requirement, all General Education courses, all core courses, and must meet with an advisor in order to register for the Capstone course. The only courses permitted to be taken with the Capstone course are GEB 4891 and MAN 4930.*
