### **Life is a “Cabaret” with IRSC Fine Arts Students Performance of Award-Winning Show**

The Indian River State College Fine Arts Program is excited to present its production of the musical “Cabaret” by Joe Masteroff with Music by John Kander. Performances will start Thursday, February 18 through February 20 at 8 p.m. and on Saturday, February 20 at 2 p.m. and on Thursday, February 25 through February 27 at 8 p.m. and Saturday, February 27 at 2 p.m.

The show is the highlight of the IRSC 2009-'10 Fine Arts season. Come and see this professionally produced show, performed by IRSC Fine Arts students, many of whom are able to be a part of this and other College Fine Arts productions through Fine Arts scholarships funded in part by ticket sales to IRSC shows.

The production is based on the play by John Van Druten and stories by Christopher Isherwood. The scene is set in a night club in Berlin, as the 1920's are drawing to a close. The Master of Ceremonies welcomes the audience to the show and assures them that, whatever their troubles, they will forget them at the Cabaret.

Musical numbers include “It Couldn't Please Me More,” “Willkommen,” “Cabaret,” and “Don't Tell Mama.” Cliff writes about Sally and the people of Berlin leading up to the Third Reich, a tumultuous and heartbreaking era in history. Cabaret received 8 Tony Awards for its original debut and 4 Tony Awards for its revival in 1997.
