The only courses permitted to be taken with the Capstone course are GEB 4891 and one of the three elective courses. GEB 4970 is recommended for online students and students who plan to attend graduate school. For students taking GEB 4970, 6 credits of electives are required. For students taking MAN 4900, 3 credits of electives are required.
