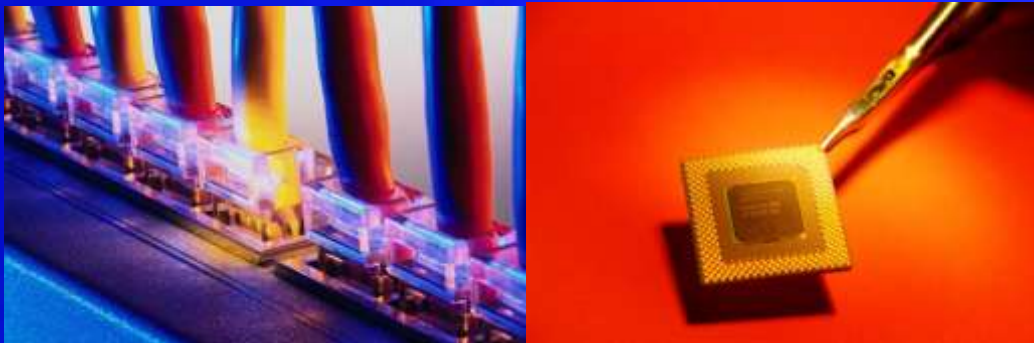

# Flexible Pathways to the Baccalaureate Degree

- **Multiple Entry Points**
  - Recent High School Grads
  - Some College
  - Associate Degree from IRSC
  - Degrees from Other Institutions
- **Multiple Completion Points**
  - Certificates
  - Associate Degrees
  - Baccalaureate Degrees




# Advantages of the IRSC 2 + 2 Format

- Open Admission for most Associate Degrees
- Multiple Completion Options
- Accelerated Workforce Entry
- Seamless Transfer of Credits
- One College Culture to Learn
- Stay Close to Home
- **Save Money**
  - **High School Dual Enrollment** (free)
  - **Associate Degree Tuition** (\$104.18 per credit hour)\*
  - **Bachelor's Degree Tuition** (\$115.54 per credit hour)\*
  - **Bachelor's Degree Tuition is about 40-50% less than local state university tuition**

# Pathway to Baccalaureate Admission

- **Recent High School Grads**
  - Choose *Appropriate Associate Degree*
  - Submit IRSC Application (no application fee)
  - Submit High School Transcripts
  - Take College Placement Test or Provide SAT/ACT Scores
  - Upon Completion of Associate Degree 
    - Choose Baccalaureate Degree
  - Pay \$30 application fee and change major code with an IRSC advisor

# Pathway to Baccalaureate Admission

- **IRSC A.A. and A.S. Degree Holders**



- Choose your baccalaureate degree program
- **Pay \$30 application fee and change your major code with an IRSC advisor**

# Pathway to Baccalaureate Admission

- **Transferring from another institution with A.A. or A.S. Degree**



- Choose your baccalaureate degree program
- **Submit IRSC application, indicate major code, pay the \$30 application fee**
- Submit transcripts from high school and all colleges attended

# Baccalaureate Admission Requirements



Complete an **appropriate A.A. or A.S. degree** from an accredited institution

Provide documentation to the Admissions Office through **receipt of college transcripts**

Nursing	=	AS in Nursing (required)
Organizational Mgmt	=	AA or AS degree
Health Care Mgmt	=	AA or AS in Health Care preferred
Human Services	=	AA or AS in Human Services preferred
Digital Media	=	AA or AS in Graphic Design or Digital Media preferred
Criminal Justice	=	AA or AS in Criminal Justice preferred
Public Administration	=	AA or AS in related field preferred
Info Tech/Security Mgmt	=	AA or AS in Computer Info Tech preferred

  - Organizational Management

  - Public Administration
  - Information Technology and Security Management



# Additional Admission Requirements

- **For Education**

- Demonstrate General Knowledge  
(beginning Fall 2010, the GK exam will be required for admission)
- Complete Education prerequisite courses:
  - EDF 2005—Introduction to the Teaching Profession
  - EDF 2085—Introduction to Diversity for Educators
  - EME 2040—Introduction to Technology for Educators

- **For Nursing**

- Valid Florida RN License



# Program Requirements

- **Education**

- Criminal background check is required prior to field experience placements in public schools
- ESE majors will need to take EEX 2010 (Intro to Special Education) as soon as possible (prerequisite requirement)

- **Organizational Management, Digital Media, Human Services, Criminal Justice, Public Administration, ITSM**

- AA degree holders will need to take 18 credits in a technical discipline in lieu of 18 credits in General Education
  - Business discipline for Organizational Management
  - Health Care discipline for Health Care Management
  - Human Service discipline for Human Services
  - Digital Media or Graphic Design discipline for Digital Media
  - Criminal Justice discipline for Criminal Justice
  - Public Service/Public Administration discipline for Public Administration
  - Computer Science or Info Tech for Info Tech and Security Management

# Transcript Review

## High School Transcripts

- **Verify Graduation**
- **Foreign Language Requirement**

**Students who have not taken two years of the same foreign language in high school will need to complete 2 semesters (8 credit hours) of the same foreign language at the college level to meet the state foreign language requirements for graduation.**

# Where Will Classes Be Held?

Most Associate Degree courses are held on all campuses

Baccalaureate Degree courses are mostly on the main campus

Expansion to branch campuses will occur over time

Many courses are available fully or partially online



# Baccalaureate Technology Expectations

# Baccalaureate Academic Expectations

- More rigorous than the Associate degree
- More study time needed per course
- Higher degree of self-direction expected
- Advanced research and library skills
- Greater use of technology
- All courses have online content
- Focus is on theory and application
- Emphasis is on demonstrating competencies
