Admissions Criteria:

- An A.A. Degree and a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 are required for program admission.
- Completion of the following Common Prerequisite courses is required for program admission:
EDF 2005 Introduction to the Teaching Profession
EDF 2085 Introduction to Diversity and Exceptionalities for Educators
EME 2040 Introduction to Technology for Educators
- Satisfactory completion of the General Knowledge portion of the Florida Teacher Certification Exam is required for admission.
- EEX 2010 Introduction to Special Education should be taken as an A.A. Degree Elective whenever possible as a prerequisite to EEX 4601.

Program Information:

- Students who have not taken two years of the same foreign language in high school must complete the second level of foreign language at the college level to meet the foreign language requirement. See College Catalog.
- Satisfactory Level II background check by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the Federal Bureau of Investigation is required prior to enrolling in any Education courses with field experience components.
- All coursework must be satisfactorily completed prior to enrolling in EDE 4936 and EDE 4940. The internship in Elementary Education and other courses in this program require placement in public/private/charter school classrooms during regular school hours. Students must be available to complete these field experience components during regular school hours.
