Admissions Criteria:

- An A.A. Degree is required for program admission.
- Satisfactory completion of the General Knowledge portion of the Florida Teacher Certification Exam is required for program admission.
- Satisfactory Level II background check by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the Federal Bureau of Investigation is required prior to enrolling in any Education courses with field experience components.
- Completion of the Education prerequisites EDF 2005, EDF 2085, EME 2040 is required for program admission.
- Satisfactory brief narrative that includes a request for program admission, factors influencing the applicant's decision to teach, the applicant's philosophy of education and previous teaching or related experiences which demonstrate the applicant's potential as an educator is required.
- Written recommendations from three individuals familiar with the applicant's academic work, personal character and/or ability to work with children and/or youth are required.

Program Information:

- Students may need to meet additional program requirements based on previous credits earned. Contact an IRSC Advisor for more information.
- Students who have not taken two years of the same foreign language in high school must complete the second level of foreign language at the college level to meet the foreign language requirement. See College Catalog.
