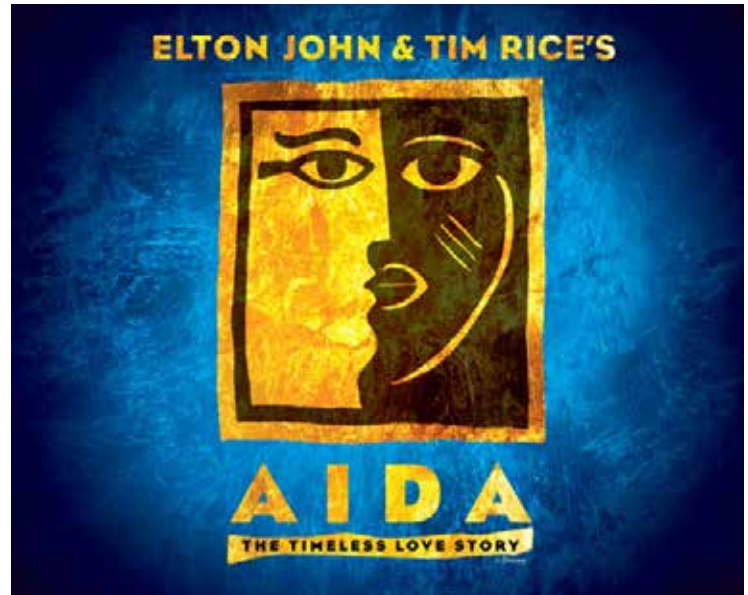

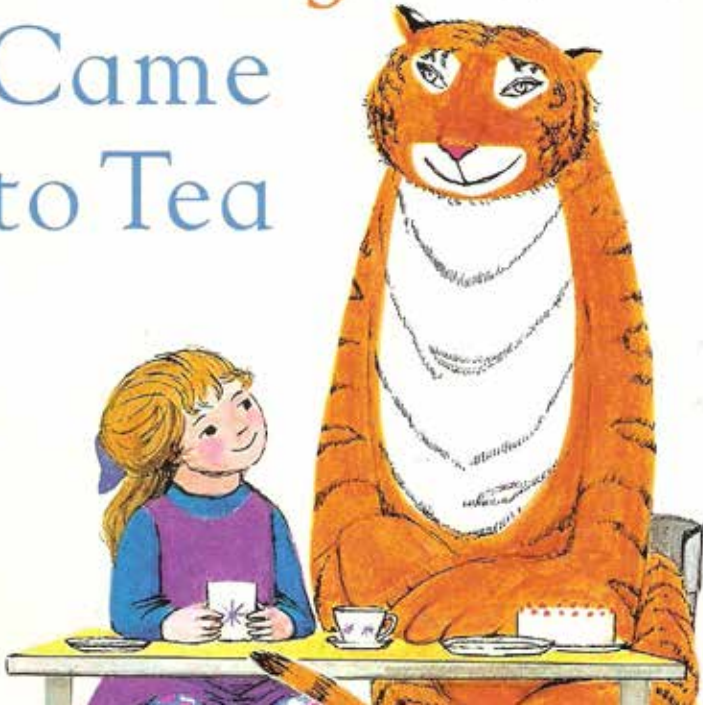

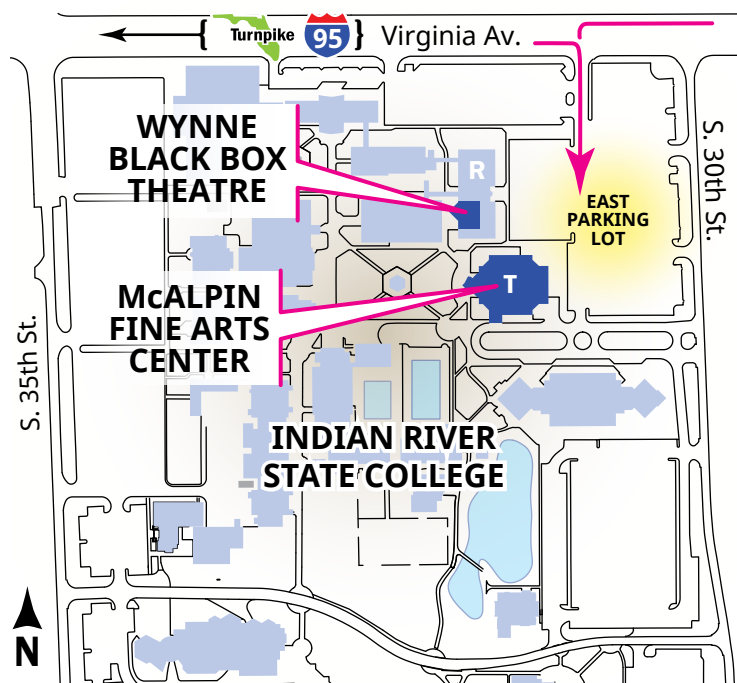
• McAlpin Fine Arts Center

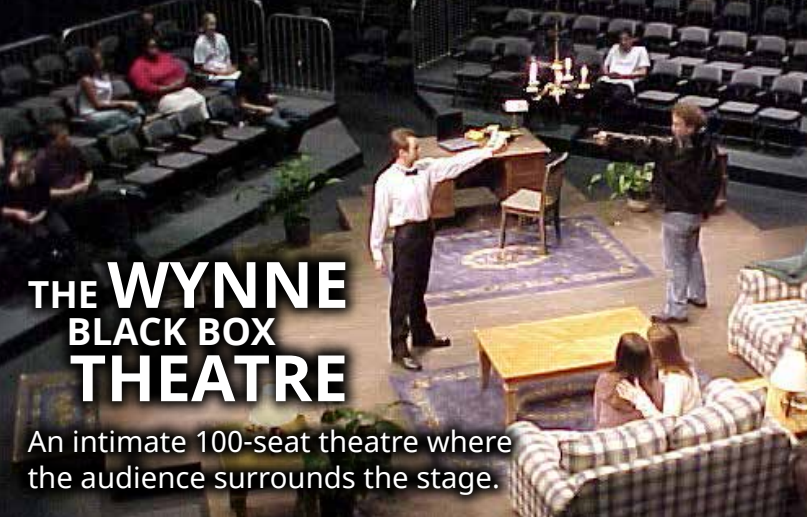
The McAlpin is located on the northeastern part of the IRSC Main Campus in Fort Pierce. Parking is available on the north and east sides of the theatre building.

An intimate 100-seat theatre where the audience surrounds the stage.

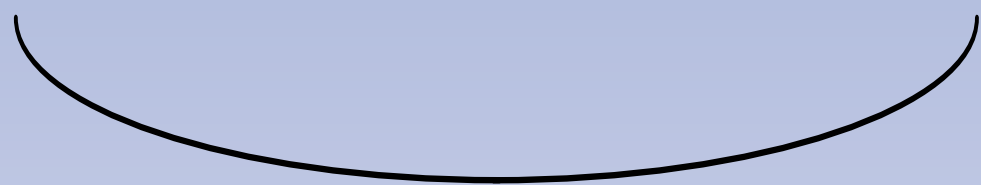


THE McALPIN FINE ARTS CENTER
